COMPLETING THE APPLICATION PROCESS With Northern Oklahoma College

First-Time Entering Freshmen (*Students entering with a high school diploma or GED*) **must submit to the Registrar:**

- 1) High school transcript reflecting GPA and class rank
OR GED Certificate.
- 2) ACT or SAT scores including subscores.

First-Time Student With Transfer Credit (*Transfer students*) **must submit to the Registrar**

- 1) Completed admission application.
- 2) Official transcripts from ALL schools previously attended need to be on file with the NOC Registrar.

Students who are at least 21 years old are not required to submit ACT/SAT scores or a high school transcript, but may be required to take placement testing.

Please read the following statements before signing.

Only signed and dated applications with appropriate attachments are considered valid.

Students are expected to complete assignments and projects in the DMAD computer lab after hours. DMAD Students will have a full access to the lab 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **There is a recommended laptop to purchase for the classes (included in the information packet). Other laptops may not perform up to industry / class standards. DMI is not responsible for your computers performance, crashes, or maintenance.
